### PROS & CONS

#### **PARK SOLUTION**

(aka GRAVEL LOT SOLUTION)

##### **Some benefits of this approach:**

- 3-Phase approach
- School addition is expandable
- Gravel lot allows “it” to be built before demo 1926
- Separate buildings for separate functions
- Highlights Church  
Adds park and visual connection campus
- Adds outdoor opportunities for neighborhood gatherings

##### **Some disadvantages to this approach:**

- Parking is divided and diminished
- Not a great playground

#### **IN-FILL SOLUTION:**

##### **Some benefits of this approach:**

- This is the EXPECTED solution
- ONE phase...
- School, Church, Parish Center and Narthex under ONE roof
- Parking remains the same
- Playground remains
- Community Room at street invites neighborhood “in” and “see” what’s happening

##### **Some disadvantages to this approach:**

- All the money must be raised, phasing is not easily achieved
- Off-site Gym, Alternative food service and portable classrooms will be required.

### NEXT STEPS:

1. Building Committee to meet and decide on the design with which we will move forward. The decision will largely be based on parishioner feedback.
2. Utilizing parishioner feedback and its collective perspective, the building committee will ask the architect to further detail the conceptual design chosen by the parish.
3. The pastor and the building committee will begin the interview process to hire a company that will lead us through a feasibility study. This study and process will establish our budget for the building project.
4. Meanwhile, the building committee will begin to host town hall meetings that solicit more detailed input from parishioners. These efforts will be included in the information the building committee provides to an Architect for construction documents.
